Description

The Physiotherapist assesses patients and plans and carries out individual and group treatment programs to maintain, improve or restore physical functioning and mobility, alleviate pain and prevent physical dysfunction in clients.

The Physiotherapist assesses and treats a variety of conditions, including neurological, cardiac, respiratory, and orthopedic issues. LWDH offers inpatient physiotherapy services available to acute and chronic inpatients from Monday to Friday, 8 am to 4 pm, with limited weekend service, and outpatient physiotherapy for general assessment and treatment for referred patients. The department also runs special programs for cardiac rehabilitation, pulmonary rehabilitation, post-total knee/hip replacement classes, and Good Living with Arthritis in Denmark (GLA:D) classes.

Qualifications

- Must be a member in good standing with the College of PT of Ontario
- Must be a graduate of a certified and accredited University, with a Bachelor or master's degree in PT
- Previous experience in hospital environment preferred
- Authorizer status for ADP mobility devices preferred
- Effective interpersonal and communication skills and ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Current Certification in BCLS and demonstrated ongoing competence through annual re-certification
- Demonstrated knowledge of computers and Windows-based software programs/keyboarding skills
- Familiarity with all PT equipment and supplies, and ability to coordinate management and maintenance of PT equipment and supplies
- Independent clinical problem-solving skills, ability to organize and prioritize work within time constraints, and demonstrated sound judgment, and initiative
- Demonstrated ability to effectively perform PT assessments and analyses, and to coordinate implementation of prioritized PT interventions utilizing available support staff and students
- Physically capable of frequent bending, stretching and lifting and of assisting heavy-needs patients with bed mobility, transfers, ambulation and exercise program. Must be able to stand and walk the major portion of the day
- Demonstrated punctuality and reliable attendance record
- Must demonstrate a tactful, empathetic, and caring patient approach, and encourage independence
