DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

FOR

BRONCHOSCOPY

1. You should not eat or drink until your gag reflex returns. (approximately 1 hour) Test your throat with a tiny sip of water to make sure you can feel the water in your throat and not choke. Once your gag reflex returns, you may resume your usual diet, unless otherwise instructed.

2. If you have been given anesthesia or sedation;

- Do not drive or operate machinery for 24 hours.
- Do not make important decisions or sign any important documents in the next 24 hours. Do not plan any activities that require complex thought or coordination for 24 hours.
- Do not consume alcohol, tranquilizers or sleeping medications for the next 24 hours.
- Sedative and narcotic medicines given during a bronchoscopy may linger for hours. You may feel dizzy for several hours after your procedure.
- You must have an adult with you tonight at home.
- **3.** You may experience throat irritation or hoarseness for a short time following the procedure.
- **4.** Restrict your activity and rest for the remainder of the day. Resume normal activity on the day following your procedure.
- **5.** Resume any medications that you were taking before your procedure.
- 6. You may note a small amount of blood in your sputum. This is of no concern after a bronchoscopy, especially if a biopsy was done.

- 7. If a biopsy was done, it will be sent to the pathologist for analysis. After 7 10 days, your physician will receive a report which he/she will call you about (if necessary) or discuss it at your follow-up appointment.
- 8. Go to an Emergency Department if any of the following occurs:
 - Chest pain
 - Persistent blood in sputum
 - High fever (38°C or 100°F)
 - Severe heartburn
 - Difficulty swallowing or breathing
 - Heart palpitations
