A Great Place to Work:

- 8 - 12 hour shifts

- 12 bed ED with two fully equipped resuscitation rooms including ED ultrasound and difficult airway equipment. Standard ED equipment available throughout the ED including slit lamp and casting room.
- Specialty consultation includes: general surgery, internal medicine, psychiatry, family medicine anesthesia, and obstetrics, which are available by request 24/7, or by transfer to a designated hospital where tertiary care can be provided (Thunder Bay and Winnipeg are referral centers)
- There is a 24 hour helicopter service available and helipads on five (5) First Nations reserves and five (5) district communities
- Radiology services for ultrasound, CT, and plain films are 24/7
- Credentialing through the Northwestern Regional E-Credentialing System (NRECS)
- LWDH meets the immediate healthcare needs of the City of Kenora, as well as a large surrounding area that includes several First Nations Communities.
- Patient volume of approximately 17,500.

Required Qualifications:

- Equivalent of one (1) year of full-time ED experience (with your independent practice license), and current ATLS, ACLS, and PALS training.
- CCFP or CCFP (EM), or FRCP (EM)
- Current valid license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
